An endowed fund for Camp Eberhart has been established by the Camp Eberhart Alumni Association, celebrating the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of camp, and in support of the camp for the next 100 years.

In order to make a meaningful impact on the operation of Camp Eberhart in the permanent future, this fund needs to grow quickly. Our goal is \$500,000 by the year 2012. We need your support.

There are several ways that you can support this new fund. All gifts are tax deductible, and some of the giving vehicles in estate planning are both income and tax advantaged. ## **How to give...**

First, to give us a good start, we are asking for your contribution in the form of a five year pledge. Give according to your ability and according to the impact that Camp Eberhart has made on your life. The Alumni Association will match the first \$15,000 given by its members. Second, we ask you to consider giving an appreciated asset to the fund. Because we have established this fund with the St. Joseph County Community Foundation in South Bend, almost any asset can be donated: Stocks, Personal Property, Artwork, Real Estate and others.

Finally, commit a part of your estate to the fund. Insert wording in your will, make Camp Eberhart the beneficiary of some life insurance, set up a Charitable Remainder Trust, or establish a Gift Annuity for the benefit of Camp. Your financial advisor and the Community Foundation can give you other ideas.
